




#### **HIV PREVENTION PROJECTS**









The Goal of the Project is to support the implementation of HIV and AIDS Prevention National Strategic Program through awareness raising, peer to peer consultation and testing for HIV among MSM, CSWs and trans people, identification of HIV sero-positive cases, and referral to the National Center for Infectious Diseases of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Armenia (NCID).


